Alpe-Adria VHF Contest ARI – OVSV – HRS – ZRS August 6, 2017

Date and time: every year on the Sunday of the first full weekend of August, from 07.00 to 15.00 UTC. This year Sunday, August 6, 2017

Bands and modes: 2-meter band from 144,000 to 144,400 MHz. Recommendation – QRP stations from 144 350 to rise, QRO stations from 144 350 to descend.

Modi – CW (A1) – SSB (J3E)

Categories – To be stated clearly in the Log:

A – fixed and portable stations, with a maximum power as a licensed

B – only CW stations, fixed and portable, maximum power as license

C – fixed and portable stations with maximum power of 50 W output

D – portable stations with a maximum power of 5 W (QRP) output, operating from QTH located above 1600 m asl

Also there will be another ranking.

Category YOUNG: young people under 25 years of age (to be indicated in the log) participants in any of the other four categories.

Multiplier: X 1 (1 point at Km).

Messages: RS (T) + progressive number of the QSO + WWQTH Locator.

Stations Laptops: It 'faculties of the participating stations (fixed or portable), if you are outside of your QTH, using the callsign / call-area (eg. IU0XYZ / 1), regardless of whether they are in or out of call membership area. Participants are reminded that is not allowed under any circumstances to change their name during the race. It should of course use the same name from the first QSO made until the end of the contest itself. In particular, where it is chosen to use the name followed by the call-area this formula must be maintained throughout the contest. There are valid QSO with Italian names / P or / M errors that will be considered during the inspection.

Log. Logs must be received within 8 days (second Tuesday) from the date of the Contest ARI Udine. It will be exclusively classified LOG electronically (as in paper format will be accepted and put control-log).

Who participates in the YOUNG category will have to specify in the "CLUB" marked "YOUNG" that in the EDI file will appear like this: = PClub YOUNG

The logs should be sent by email to **AlpeAdria (at) ariudine.it**, the reception will be confirmed acknowledgment of receipt by email.

The files must be in-formed **IARU Standard, files in * .EDI** generated with popular programs such as the Contest Assist, Taclog, QARTest etc.

The files must be named with the category followed by the name + the extension (example A_IV3AVQ.EDI, C_I1ANP.EDI, etc ..) and not ALPEADRIA.TXT, ALPE.LOG or otherwise.

Bans and Penalties – Any errors reported in the data of a QSO determines the cancellation. If there are Dupes, whose number is greater than 3% of the total number,

it will be disqualified the entire Log. They will be considered check logs Logs late and all those not properly filled out.

Awards – the first 5 stations in each category of the Contest (the trophy 1-3, 4-5 diploma) will be awarded. If in a category there will be fewer than 10 participants, will be only the first awarded with a trophy and 2-3 diploma.

He will be awarded a trophy also the winner of the YOUNG category.

The preparation of the general classification of the Contest and the awards are the International Association of care (ARI, OVSV, HRS, ZRS), which in turn takes care of the edition of the Contest. This year Italy is the nation which organizes turn. The awards will be presented during the Alpe Adria meeting is held annually in the fall near Udine; charts and information on RR, on the site www.ari.it and detailed program on the website of www.ariudine.it section.

Prizes not collected will be only on the explicit request, shipped with a charge of postage.
